Brothers Knights,





Knights Call for Action—COVID-19 Parish Help

Brother Knights:

I am hoping that you and your family are doing well during this Covid19 Pandemic. As you may well know, this Pandemic has changed the way we now do things in this world. The way we shop, the way we eat, and the way that are now able to worship.

The way that we worship now takes more people to assist in successful operation, so that we can worship. All of the Parish Staff has been assigned extra duties so that we and our families can worship. There are now Greeters, who say hello and welcome, there are more Ushers assigned to each mass. greeting parishioners and them escorting them to their pew, and making sure that they are Socially Distanced from other parishioners. There are also 2 people assigned to do the LiveStreaming, so that those parishioners at home can view Mass. Then after the Mass is concluded, the pews and the entire sanctuary needs to be sanitized. This is usually done by about 5-6 Staff members.

You are probably wondering why am I telling you this? Well the reason why is that our Knights of Columbus Council needs to step up to the Plate, and assist our Priest and the staff members that are doing these jobs 6-7 days a week. If you can assist with Ushering, Eucharistic Ministers, Sanitizing the Parish Sanctuary, or Live Streaming, please contact me, and I will put you in contact with the Parish Staff member that will explain to you how you can assist with a particular duty.

With 177 members of our Council, we should be able to get at least 8-12 members to help assist Father Brian and Staff with some of these tasks.


